Purpose and legal basis of data processing

Purpose: Traceability of infections with COVID-19

The **legal basis** for data processing is point d of Article 6(1) (D) GDPR (processing of personal data for the protection of vital interests of the data subject or another natural person). This also includes the processing of personal data for monitoring epidemics and their spread.

Further legal basis for data processing is point c of Article 6(1) GDPR in conjunction with Article 20 2 of the Fifth Infection Protection Measures Ordinance and with point 2.5 of the Hygiene Concept for Cultural Events (Joint Announcement of the Bavarian State Ministries for Health and Care and for Science and the Arts on 15.06.2020).

Recipients of the collected contact data

The collected data may only be passed on at the request of the competent health authorities for the purpose of tracing possible infection routes.

Retention period

The contact details must be kept for a period of one month and then destroyed.

Your rights with regard to the processing of your data

As a data subject, you have the right to information with regard to your collected personal data and the right to correction, as well as a right to erasure of your data after expiry of the retention period vis-à-vis Deutsches Weihnachtsmuseum GmbH. You can contact Deutsches Weihnachtsmuseum GmbH for this. Irrespective of this, Deutsches Weihnachtsmuseum GmbH will erase the data after the aforementioned retention period has expired.
